Pursuant to Article 8, paragraph 11 and Article 68 of the Law on Electronic Communications ("Official Gazette of Montenegro", No 50/08, 53/09-14 Art. 21, 70/09, 40/10-5 Art. 11 and 49/10), the Council of the Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services, on its session dated 17. 06. 2011, took the following

DECISION

on issuing a public call for expressing interest for the use of radio frequencies

1. All interested parties are invited to submit their opinion related to the conditions for use, market value and limiting of the number of authorizations for the use of radio frequencies in the following bands:
 - 880-915/925-960 MHz,
 - 1710-1785/1805-1880 MHz,
 - 1920-1980/2110-2170 MHz,
 - 3600-3800 MHz,
 - 410-430 MHz,
 - 11.7-12.5 GHz.

2. The subject of the public call are the following radio frequency resources:
 - two radio frequency blocks, with bandwidth of 2×5.2 MHz (26 two-way radio frequency channels, 200 kHz wide) in the bands of 880-915/925-960 MHz for the implementation of a GSM network on national level;
 - two radio frequency blocks, with bandwidth of 2×14 MHz (70 two-way radio frequency channels, 200 kHz wide) in the bands of 1710-1785/1805-1880 MHz for the implementation of DCS1800 network on national level;
 - a radio frequency block with bandwidth of 2×15 MHz (3 two-way radio frequency channels, 5 MHz wide) in the bands of 1920-1980/2110-2170 MHz, for the implementation of IMT-2000/UMTS network on national level;
 - a radio frequency block with bandwidth of 2×21 MHz (6 two-way radio frequency channels, 3.5 MHz wide), or a radio frequency block with the bandwidth of 2×25 MHz (5 two-way radio frequency channels, 5 MHz wide) in the bands of 3600-3800 MHz, according to the Radio Frequency Allocation Plan from frequency bands of 3600-3800 MHz for BWA systems ("Official Gazette of Montenegro", No 80/10), for the implementation of a BWA network on national level;

- a radio frequency block, with bandwidth of 2 x 2.5 MHz (2 two-way radio frequency channels, 1.25 MHz wide) in the bands of 410-430 MHz, for the implementation of CDMA PAMR network on national level (conditional);
 - two radio frequency blocks, with bandwidth of 400 MHz (20 one-way radio frequency channels, 20 MHz wide) in the bands of 11.7-12.5 GHz for the implementation of wireless distribution network for transmission and emission of signals to end-users on national level.

 4. The deadline for the submission of opinions of interested parties is 30 days from the publication of the public call.
