

Deputy Secretary-General of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), **Mr Houlin Zhao**, has visited today the Main control-measuring center for the control and monitoring of radio frequency spectrum (GKMC) on Dajbabska gora in Podgorica.

Mr Zhao said that it is extremely important that the Center is equipped in accordance with the latest standards.

- This is the most beautiful and impressive monitoring center I have ever seen. It is particularly important that is equipped with the most modern monitoring equipment. The efforts that Montenegro has put in this center is important for the whole Region. Telecommunication infrastructure in Montenegro is developing fast, and this center helps these activities to be performed in a high-quality way," stressed **Mr Zhao**.

He invited Montenegro to share its experience with other countries in the Region and added that many countries should follow the example of Montenegro.

- I must express a great appreciation for everything that has been achieved in Montenegro. I believe that you find the ITU recommendations very important, but everything would be in vain if there were not those who act in compliance with them. In its further activities the ITU will need your experts to give their contribution and share their experience with others. I expect to hear news about new achievements of your country and this center," concluded ITU Deputy General-Secretary.

Zoran Sekulić, Director of the Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services, said that in construction of the RFS monitoring system our country fully complied with the directives of the International Telecommunication Union and all its standards.

- Out of that reason and due to the fact that the ITU encourages the compliance with its own standards in other countries, **Mr Zhao** has found it appropriate to visit Montenegro and this Agency, so that the Agency would share its experience with other countries where such standards are not sufficiently respected," pointed out **Sekulić** and added that cooperation with the ITU had been agreed upon, especially within conferences to be held in the future period, but also through bilateral cooperation

- We have had an intensive and very good cooperation with the ITU. I believe that the cooperation with them will be on an upswing and I think that we will continue it after this visit," was the opinion of the Director of the Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services.
