

Public statement

During a two-day visit and participation in the International conference: Cyber Security – **Global Challenge of 21st century**, organized by the Ministry for Information Society and Telecommunications and Atlantic Alliance of Montenegro, Director of Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) of International Telecommunication Union, Mr **Brahima Sanou**, together with Mr Zoran Sekulić, Executive Director of the Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services, visited today the recently opened Main control-measuring center on Dajbabska gora.



During the visit, Mr Sanou got acquainted with the concept of the System for control and monitoring of radio-frequency spectrum and measuring equipment and devices that the Agency has for the needs of monitoring of radio frequency spectrum in bandwidths of 9 kHz to 3 GHz, as well as with mobile control-measuring stations for the monitoring of digital radio emissions on the move. He was also presented the concept and functional connection with other fixed stations of the System, which is very important for Montenegro.

On this occasion Mr Sanou said he was impressed by the level of this system development and expressed his belief that this unique facility would be used for regional meetings and conferences of regulators in the area of electronic communications. He also announced further common activities of the ITU and the Agency related to this matter.

Mr Sekulić thanked the high official and one of the ITU Directors for this visit and his proposals for further improvement of cooperation and support of the ITU to our administration.
