

Further to Article Article 97, paragraph 4 of the Law on Electronic Communications (Official Gazette of Montenegro No. 50/08), the Ministry of Transport, Maritime Affairs, and Telecommunications enacts the

**RULEBOOK**  
**on the methodology and the method of calculation of the annual fee**  
**for the use of numbering and/or addresses**

**Article 1**

This Rulebook stipulates the methodology and the method of calculation of the annual fee for the use of numbering and/or addresses, which are to be paid to the Agency for Electronic Communications and Postal Services (hereinafter referred to as: the Agency).

**Article 2**

The amount of annual fee for the use of the approved numbering and/or addresses is calculated on the basis of the number of points established for individual numbers, blocks of numbers, short codes, and addresses and the amount of the money value of the point, which shall be initiated by the Agency.

**Article 3**

The number of points shall be determined on the basis of the use, type, and number of digits in a numeration and/or address specified by the Numbering Plan and the Address Plan, so that the number of points for individual types of numerations and addresses is as follows:

<b>GEOGRAPHIC NUMBERS</b>		
1.)	- Individually (6-digit) assigned number	0.10 points
<b>NON-GEOGRAPHIC NUMBERS</b>		
2.)	<b>Non-geographic numbers for mobile networks (access code 6x)</b> - Individually (6-digit and 7-digit) assigned number	0.10 points
3.)	<b>Non-geographic numbers for services of VOIP voice transmission via Internet (access code 78)</b> - Individually (6-digit) assigned number	0.10 points
4.)	<b>Non-geographic numbers for Free phone services (access code 80)</b> - Individually (6-digit) assigned number	100 points
5.)	<b>Non-geographic numbers for value added service (access codes 94 and 95)</b> - Individually (6-digit) assigned number	100 points
<b>CALL NUMBERS OF SPECIAL SERVICES (2-5 DIGITS)</b>		
6.)	Short codes – three-digit assigned number	10,000 points
7.)	Short codes – four-digit assigned number	1,000 points
8.)	Short codes – five-digit assigned number	100 points
<b>CODES/ADDRESSES</b>		
10.)	International Signaling Point Code (ISPC)	10,000 points

11.)	National Signaling Point Code (NSPC)	1,000 points
12.)	Data Network Identification Code (DNIC)	1,000 points
13.)	Mobile Network Code (MNC)	1,000 points

#### **Article 4**

Fee for the reserved numbering and/or addresses is determined by reducing the number of points from article 3 of this Rulebook by 50%.

Reservation of numbering and/or addresses shall be made for a period of one year, with the possibility of extension for maximum one additional year.

#### **Article 5**

This Rulebook shall come into force on the eighth day from the date of its publishing in the *Official Gazette of Montenegro*.
